Q. Will there be a Stakeholders Meeting for Cannabis Facilities?

A. BFS Cannabis Division is currently planning a virtual training session for BFS plan review applications. More information to follow via email. This virtual session will go through the steps necessary to submit cannabis plans online through BFS Accela. It will cover how to register for BFS Accela Citizen Access, ACA, how to fill out an application, how to download drawings to the application and how to view Plan Review Reports online. One goal is to record this session and have it available on our website.

Q. Can some training or information be provided on common compliance issues and how to avoid them? A. Yes, this is possible. The feedback from our Survey has provided us a lot of information that we are currently working on. Right now, the best way to accomplish this is to ask a fire inspector the next time they are at the facility.

Q. Can BFS provide a virtual training on CRA Enforcement Reporting Forms?

A. The CRA Enforcement Report Forms (RF) are a big part of the CRA operations. BFS does deal with part of the RF and is currently working with CRA to update our process. In the future, after our Accela Plan Review training session, BFS is planning to have a similar online training session for Reporting Forms.
