

MANISTEE COUNTY FIRE INSTRUCTOR I COURSE



Course Description: This course (BFS Course Code H07C) is designed to meet the NFPA 1041 Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications, Instructor 1 Level. It teaches firefighters the knowledge and skills needed to deliver effective instruction from prepared lesson plans. This course utilizes the Jones and Bartlett Fire and Emergency Services Instructor, 3rd Edition textbook. The course includes instructor and student lectures throughout the course, covering eight chapters in the Jones and Bartlett textbook. Significant student preparation and homework completion are required. The course is limited to 16 students.

Course Dates and Times:

This 40-Hour course will be held on April 28, 29, and 30 and on May 6 and 7, 2023. Classes will meet from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM on all days.

Student Prerequisites:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be a member of an organized fire department
- Must have at least 3 years of fire service experience from the date of initial certification.
