The Oakland Fire Training Institute offers training that provides firefighters with compressive training environment that allows simulated real life multistory firefighter practice, for firefighter students. Students will practice and build personal safety skills (and preparing them to be members of a RIT). Skills include SCBA usage and emergencies, advancing hose lines for fire attack and rescue. They will also learn and practice the individual techniques and skills involved in firefighter rescue. Fire ground operation (proactive tasks, tool use, staging and more) will be demonstrated and student practice of many basic fire ground operations will be part of the skill-based format.
