The Fire Officer I course is designed to place emphasis on the understanding and application of leadership theories and traits, challenges, and how we use leadership to reach objectives. We will also discuss basic principles and methods of community risk reduction.

Prerequisites:

- Firefighter II
- Fire Instructor I

Course Details: This course will be done virtually using ZOOM as a platform and independent study. The students will be required to be available every Wednesday from 1800-2000 to have discussion and dialogue with the instructor and students. To be successful students must take and pass written examination with a 70%. Students are also required to complete all JPR projects successfully.

Course dates: January 11, 2023 – March 8, 2023 class will meet online on Wednesdays from 1800 - 2000 and the State certification exam will be held at Egelston Twp Fire Dept. on either March 22 or March 29, 2023
