

St Joseph County Training Committee Michigan Fire INSTRUCTOR 1

This course is designed to meet the NFPA 1041 (2019) Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications, Instructor 1 Level. This course includes instructor and student lectures throughout the course covering the Jones and Bartlett Fire and Emergency Services Instructor 3rd edition textbook. Significant student preparation and homework completion is required prior to the first day of class. Prior to the start date, you will need to read the required chapters.

- Must be a current member, or have been a member within the last five years of an organized Michigan fire department
- Must possess a Fire Fighter I and II certification
- Must complete the FFTD Instructor Orientation which is built into day four
- Must have a minimum of five (5) years of firefighting experience at the time of application
