Online meetings will be on Wednesdays from 1800-2200hrs starting on 7/12/2023 thru 9/13/2023, with a testing date of 9/25/2023

Cost: **Free** (not including course materials)

Maximum students per class: 20

Student Prerequisites: * Eighteen years of age or older on the test date. * Member of an organized Michigan Fire Department for 3 years from initial certification. * Must be certified at the fire fighter II level. * Must have attended and passed the Instructor I course. No exceptions.

Sign up process: The student must contact the course manager (below), show proof of prerequisite requirements, and then sign up in SMOKE (once approved).
