Class is held over 10 weeks and will at a minimum cover one chapter each week for 8 weeks with 2 weeks to allow you to finish up all your Job Performance Requirements (JPR) / skill objectives assignments that will allow you to take the NFPA 1021 Fire Officer I certification examination. There will also be extensive homework.

Course Description: This NFPA 1021 Fire Officer I course meets the minimum and current NFPA 1021 Standards for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications 2020 edition per Michigan Public Act 291. The course complies with NFPA 1021 including skill activities that meet the Job Performance Requirements (JPR) in the standard. Class is designed to be taught in person.

Student Prerequisites:

- Active Firefighter with 3 years minimum experience
- Must be Certified at the Fire Fighter II level
- Must have completed Fire Instructor I

Student must also register on the SMOKE website 30 days prior to the start of the class. You must also register with Schoolcraft College.
