If the license is suspended for more than six months, the Respondent must apply for reinstatement. The Respondent is fined \$5,000.00 to be paid prior to reinstatement. If reinstated within six months, the Respondent is placed on probation for one year with Board-approved reviewer to review practice/records and provide quarterly reports. Automatic discharge with compliance, provided that four satisfactory quarterly reports are received. Failure to comply with the terms of probation will result in a minimum one-day suspension until compliant. If the license remains suspended for more than six months, the Respondent must apply for reinstatement.
