Rules Update

MacIntosh stated that there were a few comments received at public hearing that need to be addressed by the rules committee. The rules committee will meet on August 29, 2022, and the committee recommendations will be brought before the full board for a vote at the September meeting.

FSMB's 110th Annual Meeting Report

In April 2022, Moiin attended FSMB's 110th Annual Meeting, held in New Orleans, Louisiana. He stated that FSMB reiterated that they are there to provide guidance for state boards, not oversee. He stated that many resolutions were voted on covering topics such as diversity/inclusion/equity, telemedicine, and vaccinations.

Chair Report

Chafty stated that the role of chairperson is much more than keeping the meeting going. There are difficult decisions that he has had to make over the last couple of years to protect the public.

Department Update

MacIntosh stated that Amy Gumbrecht had been named Director of the Bureau of Professional Licensing.

MacIntosh stated that the Bureau will hold the next new Board Member Training on August 15, 2022. All members are welcome to attend.

MacIntosh stated that recent legislation passed requiring that board meetings be recorded. He stated that the board will need to be mindful microphones and to please make sure to speak loudly and clearly.

MacIntosh reminded the board members to continue to check their state email address regularly. Wysack added that the board is short members and quorum needs to be tracked closely, so timely responses to emails was important.

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Tynes stated that he attended a meeting with the Michigan State Medical Society recently and that a legislative speaker misrepresented the stance of the Michigan Board of Medicine on Michigan opting out of the CMS physician supervision of CRNAs requirement.

Moiin asked how the implicit bias training requirement was being managed. MacIntosh explained that it was not a continuing education requirement, covered under the Michigan Board of Medicine rules. Rather, it was covered under the Public Health Code – General Rules.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Cody Weston, MD, Ph.D. commented on the USMLE timeframe outlined in the rules and the possible barriers that it can create.
