Abcott Institute: Anne Rosko-Loehnis, MSN, RN is the new director of nursing for the program.

Application for Initial Approval:

Serenity Health Training Institute: The program was asked to provide more detailed specific information on how pediatric clinicals, including any simulation, will be handled. The material was approved, and a site visit was ordered. Initial approval depends upon approval of the site visit report.

Self-Study for Full Approval:

Wayne County Community College – Belleville: The application was denied at the May meeting. The program was asked to submit a Systematic Program Evaluation Plan for the June 3, 2021 board meeting. The requested material was submitted. The self-study was approved and the program was granted full approval.

Informational Changes:

North Central Michigan College: Brent LaFaive, MSN, MHA, RN, CWCN has been named the Dean of Nursing for the program.

Wayne County Community College – Detroit: The program received initial accreditation from ACEN. Date of initial accreditation is October 5, 2018.

Wayne State University: Dr. Ramona Benkert will serve as the interim director of nursing from August 21, 2020 -July 1, 2021 while Dr. Laurie Lauzon Clabo is serving as interim Provost and Sr. Vice President for Academic Affairs of the university.

Nursing Education Program Report:

Madonna University: The Nursing Education Program Report was not approved. The program is requested to clarify the total number of program credits (Nursing and General Education) and the breakdown of credits. Additionally, the program is asked to provide the completion rates per graduation cohort for the last 3 graduating classes.

Major Program Change:

Baker College – Auburn Hills: The program plans to move to a new location in Royal Oak. The committee denied the request and requested that the program supply further clarification on how it will evaluate the change.

Finlandia University: The program would like to decrease total program credits from 126 to 124 resulting from changes related to general education requirements. This approval will be retroactive to September 2019. The Major Program Change was approved.

Kirtland Community College: The program requested curriculum revisions to integrate content and decrease program credits. The Major Program Change was approved.

Monroe County Community College: Due to limitations of face-to-face instruction caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the program proposed to utilize a blended method of instruction for all nursing course until such time as it is safe to return to face to face instruction. The Major Program Change was approved.

Oakland University: The program is seeking approval for a temporary curriculum change to support an increase up to 50% usage of virtual clinical and lab experiences due to the COVID pandemic. The Major Program Change was approved.

Minor Program Change:

Siena Heights University: This proposal is to pilot a blended delivery model for NUR 450 in the fall 2021 semester. The students will attend traditional class sessions and utilize online Lippincott “The Point” learning activities/virtual simulations to allow for small group learning team meetings across the semester. The Minor Program Change was approved.
