If Respondent's license is reinstated within six months, Respondent is placed on probation for a minimum of one year not to exceed two years to be reduced only while employed as a nurse. The terms of probation include compliance with HPRP, if monitoring is required, and quarterly employment reports totaling at least four satisfactory quarterly reports of employment. If unable to demonstrate one year of satisfactory employment, Respondent may submit to a pre-approved skills assessment no sooner than 90 days prior to the end of the maximum period of probation. Respondent's license shall be automatically suspended for a minimum of one day if noncompliant with the employment reporting requirements of probation and then automatically reinstated if Respondent complies within six months of the automatic suspension. Reinstatement is not automatic if suspended for more than six months.
