The period of limitation shall only be reduced while employed as a nurse and Respondent shall petition for reclassification at the conclusion of the limitation period. Respondent is placed on probation to run concurrently with the limitation period. The terms of probation require a minimum of eight satisfactory quarterly supervisory reports, providing satisfactory proof of completing continuing education in disciplinary actions, professional accountability and legal liability, and ethics in nursing practice within 90 days, which shall not count toward current renewal requirements. Respondent shall be automatically discharged from probation upon reclassification, provided Respondent paid the fine and complied within the terms of the order. Respondent is fined \$500.00 payable within 90 days. If noncompliant, Respondent's license shall be automatically suspended for a minimum of one day. If Respondent complies with the order within six months of the automatic

suspension, the license shall be automatically reinstated. If the license remains suspended for more than six months, Respondent must apply for reinstatement.
