If the license remains suspended for more than six months, reinstatement is not automatic. If reinstated within six months, Respondent is placed on probation for two years not to exceed three years. The terms of probation include compliance with HPRP, if monitoring is required, and submission of quarterly employment reports. If unable to obtain two years of employment as a registered nurse, Respondent shall submit to a pre-approved skills assessment no sooner than 90 days before the end of the maximum period of probation. Respondent is fined \$500.00 payable within 90 days.

If Respondent is unable to obtain two years of employment as a registered nurse, Respondent shall submit to a pre-approved skills assessment no sooner than 90 days before the end of the maximum period of probation. Respondent is fined \$250.00 payable within 90 days.
