The terms of probation require HPRP, if monitoring is required, at least eight quarterly reports of employment, and completion of continuing education within 90 days in understanding substance use disorder and professional accountability & legal liability. If unable to obtain two years of employment, Respondent shall submit to a pre-approved skills assessment no sooner than 90 days before the end of the maximum period of probation. Respondent is fined \$250.00 to be paid within 90 days.
