Upon automatic reinstatement, license is limited for a minimum period of five years to prohibit the prescribing, administering, dispensing, obtaining and possession of controlled substances, unless the controlled substance is prescribed, dispensed, or administered by a licensed health professional for Respondent as a patient. Reclassification of the license is not automatic. Upon automatic reinstatement, the Respondent is placed on probation for a minimum of one day, not to exceed three months to complete eight hours of pre-approved continuing education in ethics, which will not count towards renewal requirements. Respondent will be automatically discharged upon successful compliance.
