

Bureau of Professional Licensing Pharmacy Manufacturer Wholesaler FAQ

1. How long is a Pharmacy/Manufacturer/Wholesaler license issued for?

An initial license is valid for 2 years from the date of initial licensure.

2. When can I renew my license? How do I renew my license?

Licensees can begin to renew their licenses approximately 90 days prior to the expiration date of their current license.

Licensees will be sent a renewal notification approximately 90 days prior to the expiration date of the license. Remember to notify the Department of any address changes (this includes email address changes). You can update your address by visiting www.michigan.gov/miplus. It's a licensee's responsibility to renew his or her license on time. Failure to receive the renewal notification, or to notify the department of an address change, does not exempt a licensee from renewing their license on time.

Licensees are required to renew their license(s) by using the online renewal system located at www.michigan.gov/miplus.
