

POLICY STATEMENT ON ADDRESSES IN THE STATE

The Business Corporation Act, the Nonprofit Corporation Act, and the Limited Liability Company Act require corporations and limited liability companies to maintain in this state a registered office and a resident agent.

The Michigan Revised Uniform Limited Partnership Act provides that each domestic limited partnership shall maintain an agent for service of process in the state and that a foreign limited partnership shall report the name and address of its agent for service of process.

Registered office addresses and the agent for service of process addresses outside the state will not be permitted. However, in some rare cases where a Michigan address borders on Ohio, Indiana, or Wisconsin, the agent would be permitted to have an address outside of Michigan as long as the registered office itself was physically located in Michigan.

The above policy shall be adopted immediately and remain in effect unless rescinded or modified by the Bureau Director.
