 - Since this document will be maintained on electronic format, it is important that the filing be legible. Documents with poor black and white contrast, or otherwise illegible, will be rejected.
- 3. This document is to be used pursuant to section 1021 of the Act by foreign nonprofit corporations having a certificate of authority to conduct affairs in this State where the information contained in its original or last amended application has changed. This amended application must be filed no later than 30 days after the time the change becomes effective in the jurisdiction of its incorporation.
- 4. Item 12- This item should state only the specific affairs to be conducted in Michigan. An all purpose activities statement is not permitted. Foreign corporations can only conduct affairs in this State that a domestic corporation formed under the Nonprofit Corporation Act can lawfully transact.
