



## Resident Trainee Sponsor Approval Certification

### Resident Trainee Sponsor Certification:

R 339.18901(c) and 339.1808(4) and R 339.18925

Article 18 of the Occupational Code, Act 299 of 1980, requires that not more than 1 resident trainee shall be supervised by a licensee. Further, the supervisor for a trainee shall be actively connected with a funeral establishment. The administrative rules governing Mortuary Science define "sponsor" in R 339.18901(c) and provide specific information on the minimum practical experience requirements.
