**DEFAULT JUDGMENT**


At a session of said Court, held on December 7, 2022,  
in the City of Lansing, Michigan.

Present: HON. JAMES S. JAMO

In conjunction with a Complaint filed in the above-captioned matter, Plaintiff brought a motion for default judgment. Defendant Jason Jodway was provided an opportunity to respond, and a <sup>but failed</sup> hearing <sup>Default entered 459</sup> was held in this Court. ~~Now, for the reasons stated on the record,~~ IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Defendant is held to have violated the Michigan Uniform Securities Act, MCL 451.2101 *et seq.*, by acting as an unregistered agent in the sale of securities to Michigan investors; by acting as an unregistered investment adviser and investment adviser representative; and by omitting material information necessary to make other statements made not misleading in connection with the offer and sale of securities.
2. Defendant is hereby permanently enjoined, whether acting directly or through any person, entity, or other device, from engaging in conduct in violation of the Michigan Uniform Securities Act, MCL 451.2101 *et seq.*
3. This is a final order, resolves the last pending claim, and closes the case.
