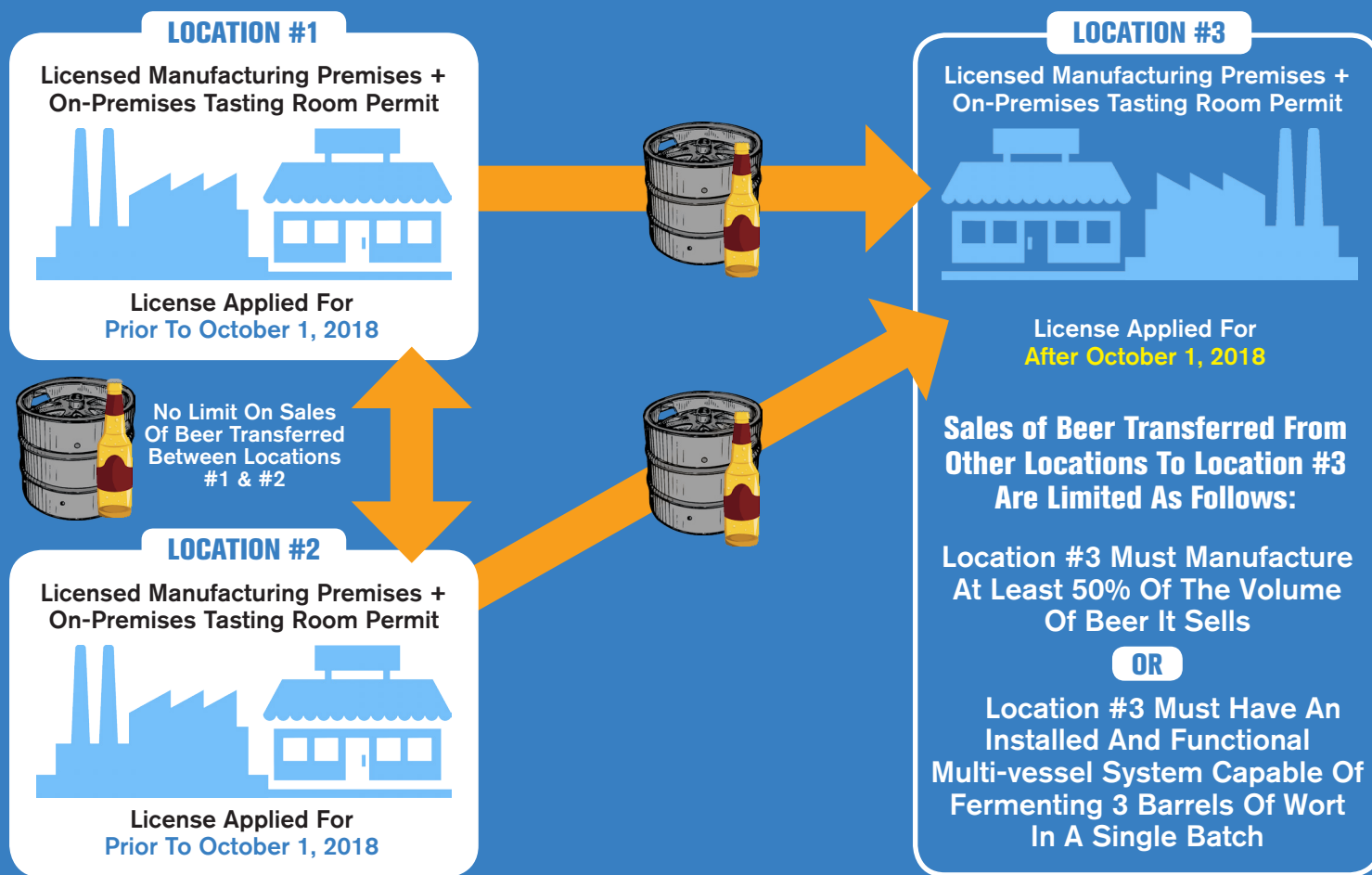


Transfers of Beer Between Locations Owned By The Same Micro Brewer Licensee

(Pursuant to MCL 436.1411)



Pursuant to MCL 436.1411(2), a Brewer or Micro Brewer licensee may sell beer it manufactures to customers at an approved tasting room issued an On-Premises Tasting Room Permit under MCL 436.1536(7), with the following limits on the number of tasting rooms:

- A Brewer licensee may have no more than two (2) approved tasting rooms.
- A Micro Brewer licensee that produces more than 30,000 barrels of beer a year may have no more than three (3) approved tasting rooms.
- A Micro Brewer licensee that produces fewer than 30,000 barrels of beer a year has no limit on the number of tasting rooms where it may serve its beer.

Pursuant to MCL 436.1411(3), a Brewer or Micro Brewer licensee may sell beer that it has manufactured at one of its licensed manufacturing premises at an approved tasting room located at another one of its licensed manufacturing premises if one of the following requirements is met at the location that receives the beer:

- The application for licensure of manufacturing premises where the approved tasting room is located was submitted prior to October 1, 2018.
- The manufacturing premises produces at least 50% of the volume of the beer sold at the approved tasting room.
- The manufacturing premises have an installed functional multi-vessel system capable of fermenting three (3) barrels of wort in a single batch.
