### **ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION FROM COMMISSIONERS OR DEPARTMENT**

Mr. Jones discussed the status of the pending Unarmed Combat Commission rule changes, the timeline for approval, and the upcoming public hearing concerning those rule changes starting at 1 PM on December 16, 2021. Written public comments concerning the rule changes are due by January 6, 2022.

Mr. Weatherspoon, the chair of the Commission's Rules Subcommittee, expressed a desire to render the Unarmed Combat Regulatory Act more consistent with statutes administered by most other states concerning the selection and approval of unarmed combat event officials. Deputy Director Pendleton explained that LARA would seek a bill sponsor within the Legislature after the Commission determines what specific statutory revisions are needed. Mr. St. Onge emphasized that statutory revisions can only be made by the Legislature, and that rules promulgated by the Commission that explain statutory requirements may not conflict with those requirements. He also recommended that more newly appointed Commission members carefully review the existing Act and rule set to understand precisely what conduct and which persons the Commission is currently responsible for regulating. This also generated questions from the more newly appointed Commission members about current Commission member involvement in approving contestant matches and whether to reestablish the Commission's Health & Safety Subcommittee or establish other subcommittees.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Michigan Unarmed Combat Commission will be held on March 10, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.
