Covering Court of Appeals activity from September 1, 2023 – September 30, 2023

A. MERC cases pending before the Michigan Court of Appeals:

- Superior Township Fire Fighters Union, Local 3292, International Association of Fire Fighters -and- Lee Rudowski***
Unfair Labor Practice Not Found: Charging Party Failed to Establish That the Union Breached its Duty of Fair Representation By Failing to Advance His Grievance Challenging His Termination to Arbitration; Charging Party's Disagreement with the Union's Decision to Not Arbitrate His Grievance is Insufficient to Establish a Breach of the Duty of Fair Representation.
MERC Case No. 21-I-1764-CU, issued March 17, 2023
Court of Appeals No. 365650
- Detroit Public Schools Community District -and- LC Bulger***
Unfair Labor Practice Not Found: Commission Remanded to ALJ For Supplemental Findings on Section 10(1)(a) Retaliation Claim Raised in Initial Charge; Following Remand, the ALJ Concluded That There Was No Basis to Support a Section 10(1)(a) Claim and Recommended Dismissal; Commission Found Charging Party Was Terminated For Failing to Report to Work, Not For Any Protected Concerted Activity That He Was Engaged In; A Withholding of Services Constitutes a Strike Under Section 2 of PERA, and While Concerted, Strikes Are Not Protected; Charging Party Failed to Provide Sufficient Evidence to Overturn the ALJ's Credibility Determinations.

Court of Appeals No. 366447

- Technical Professional Officeworkers Association of Michigan -and- Daniel Lee Renner***
Unfair Labor Practice Found: Respondent's "Nonmember Payment For Labor Representation Services" Operating Procedure Unlawfully Discriminated Against Nonunion Members and Restrained Employees From Exercising Their § 9 Right to Refrain

From Joining or Assisting a Labor Organization Under PA 349; Respondent Violated § 10(2)(a) by Refusing to File or Process Charging Party's Grievance Unless He Paid Respondent a Fee for its Services; Respondent's Operating Procedure Impacted Terms and Conditions and Employment and Implicated § 9 Rights; Therefore, it Was Not an Internal Union Matter Outside the Scope of PERA.

MERC Case No CU18 J-034, issued December 10, 2019

Court of Appeals No. 351991, issued January 7, 2021, affirmed MERC's Decision.

Supreme Court No. 162601. **Oral argument was held on October 5, 2023.**

2. ***Kalamazoo Education Association, MEA/NEA -and- Kalamazoo Public Schools***

Unfair Labor Practice Not Found: Union's Advancement to Arbitration of a Grievance Challenging the Transfer of a Guidance Counselor From the Non-Instructional Position She Held to a Teaching Position Did Not Violate Section 10(2)(d); Commission Found that the Term "Teacher" Within the Phrase "Teacher Placement" Under Section 15(3)(j) meant a Certificated Individual Employed as a Teacher; Consequently, the Bargaining Prohibitions of Section 15(3)(j) Were Not Violated By the Union's Advancement of the Grievance to Arbitration.

MERC Case No. 21-G-1465-CU, issued October 11, 2022

Court of Appeals No. 363573, issued August 10, 2023. COA Majority Decision reversed MERC's findings and remanded for further proceedings.

Supreme Court No. 166145. **Application for Leave was filed with the Supreme Court on September 20, 2023.**
