## PRE-Employment Transition Services (PRE-ETS)

### WHAT ARE PRE-ETS?

Pre-ETS programming is available to students aged 14-26 with a documented disability who are enrolled in high school or post-secondary education/training.

The goal of Pre-ETS is to help students with disabilities explore, increase awareness, and prepare for post-secondary employment and education options through five core services.

### Pre-ETS 5 Core Services



#### JOB EXPLORATION COUNSELING

Seminars or workshops on careers and required skills, career ladders and interest inventory.



#### WORKPLACE READINESS TRAINING

Development of transferable work skills which may include resume writing, interview skills, professionalism, assistive technology and independent living training.



#### WORK-BASED LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Opportunities to complete job shadows, informational interviews, internships and paid or unpaid work experiences.



#### COUNSELING IN POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION OR TRAINING

Counseling and guidance about options upon exiting high school which may include academic or vocational programs.



#### SELF-ADVOCACY

Development of individual advocacy skills and rights and responsibilities.
