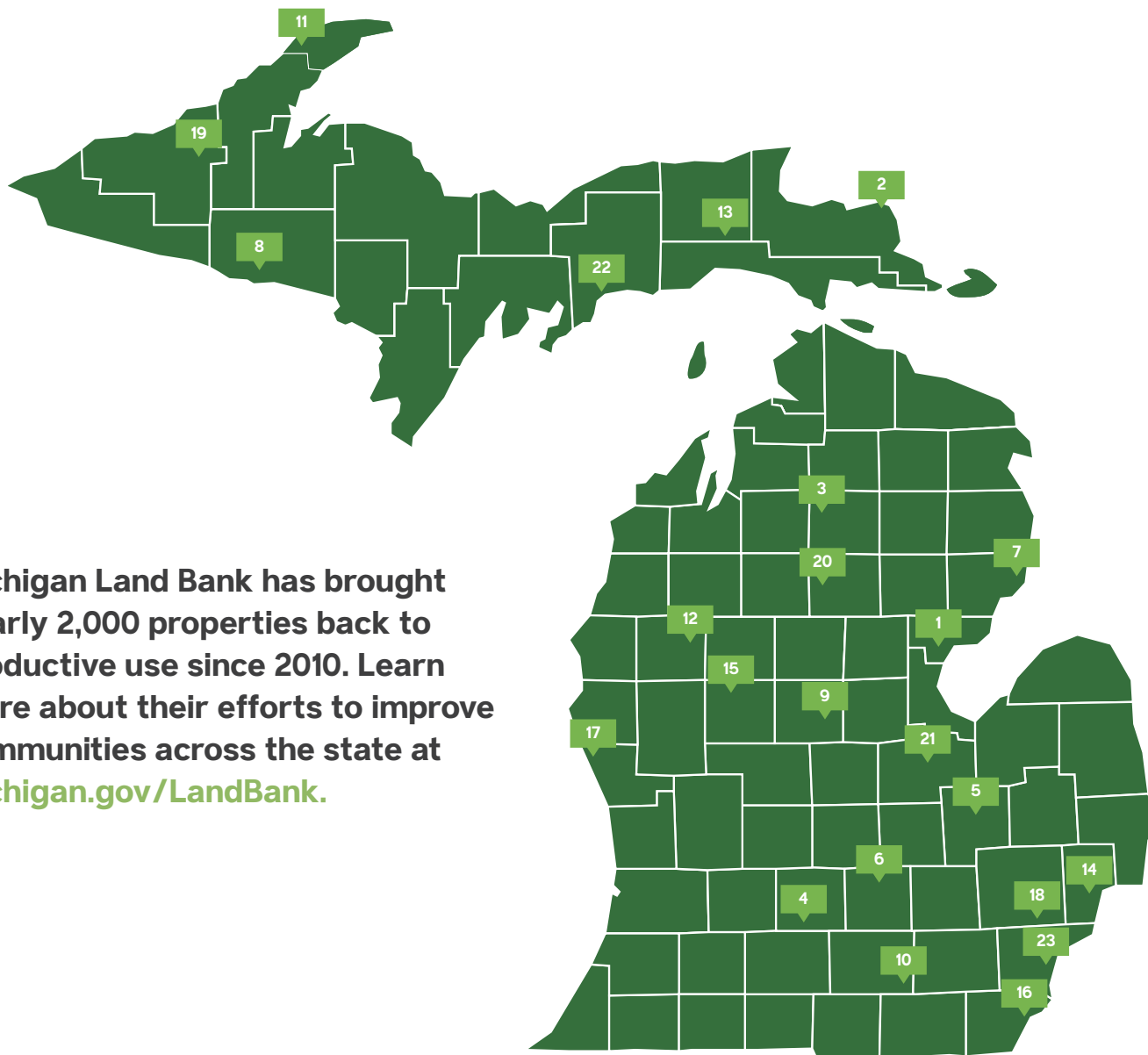


MICHIGAN LAND BANK PROPERTIES IN OPPORTUNITY ZONES
