## 2 MIOSHA Training Institute

The MTI introduced an Assessment-Based Certificate program, effective October 1, 2007. The certificate program offers participants an opportunity to be recognized for their educational efforts and increased technical expertise. Courses are offered throughout the state in sponsorship with other M-TEC<sup>SM</sup> facilities, community colleges, and safety and health organizations. ## 3 What You'll Learn . . .

This seminar is designed to give participants an understanding of the requirements of MIOSHA's Part 380 - Occupational Noise Exposure. Topics covered include: definition of noise, hearing loss and how it can occur, determining when and why to conduct noise monitoring, determining when a Standard Threshold Shift (STS) occurs and when to record it on the 300 log, noise training requirements, noise control technologies, and how to select proper hearing protection. Participants will have "hands-on" opportunities to use noise dosimeters/sound level meters and calibrators and assess noise levels associated with actual noise sources. **Virtual classroom with an in-person instructor.** **This training format can be taken from the office, home, or remotely.**
