# Use MIOSHA as a Resource to Protect Employees

## On-site Consultative Services

Michigan employers may request a voluntary MIOSHA inspection of their workplace (full or partial) **without fines or penalties**. These on-site consultations are conducted by occupational safety consultants or industrial hygienists through the CET consultation program.

*Employers must agree, prior to the start of this inspection, to correct all serious violations found during the voluntary inspection.*
