

WHAT IS MCTI?

Since 1944, the Michigan Career and Technical Institute (MCTI) has provided training for adults with disabilities in Michigan. Today, MCTI is the second largest comprehensive rehabilitation training center in the Untied States, offering a unique blend of caring human support services and state-of-the-art training.

The school is administered by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, within the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity, and is accredited by the Council on Occupational Education (COE).

YOUR SUCCESS IS OUR MISSION.

The Michigan Career and Technical Institute conducts vocational and technical training programs and provides the support services needed to prepare Michigan citizens with disabilities for competitive employment.

WHO ATTENDS MCTI?

Students who are 18 years of age or older may be referred by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, Veteran Affairs Bureau of Services for Blind Persons, other private rehabilitation agencies.



STEP 1.

Agency accepts student.



STEP 2.

Agency sends a referral to MCTI.



STEP 3.

Application is assessed.



STEP 4.

Student attends MCTI.

Adults who have a documented disability and are referred by Michigan Rehabilitation Services or the Bureau of Services for Blind Persons are eligible for **FREE TUITION** and **FREE ROOM AND BOARD** in the dormitory.
