MRS Student Career Services





First Level: Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS)

MRS coordinates with students to <u>explore</u> careers by:

- Offering services to explore employment and training opportunities
- Providing supports to students beginning at age 14 and through graduation

What are the Services?

Pre-ETS helps students explore career paths after high school through services such as:

- Job Exploration
- Work Experiences
- Training & College Exploration
- · Work-Readiness Training
- · Self-Advocacy Training

Second Level: Individualized Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)

MRS coordinates with students to *plan* for careers by:

- Offering services to eligible students on preparing to enter the workforce, exploring career options, and transitioning into employment
- Providing supports to students before graduation, anyone enrolled in 18-26 transition programming, or anyone after graduation

What are the Services?

May include any of the five pre-ETS, plus additional services as needed:

- Supports and services leading to postsecondary, job training or apprenticeship
- Connecting with the Michigan Career & Technical Institute
- · Finding and keeping a job

Students who can be referred:

Students ages 14-26 with IEPs, 504 plans or other medical/mental health documentation can request Pre-ETS or VR services at any time.

Schools and local VR agencies work together to provide services.
