1094m (3) – Clare-Gladwin regional educational service district	Clare-Gladwin ISD	\$15,000,000	\$7,500,000	During the second reporting period of the grant, the Clare-Gladwin RESD team collaborated with industry advisory committees and the Clare-Gladwin RESD Building and Grounds team to finalize a master site plan for the John C. Magnus Center. After the site plan was finalized, the team completed the design and construction for the CTE Magnus Center. After the construction manager presented the schematic budget, the Clare-Gladwin RESD team reviewed multiple value engineering strategies to ensure the project stayed within budget. Additionally, this plan was presented to the Clare-Gladwin RESD Board of Education for feedback and review. In addition to finalizing the site and architectural plans, the Clare-Gladwin RESD team continued working with DTE for natural gas supply and Consumers Energy for three-phase power. At this time approximately 15% of the project is completed.
