**SUBJECT:** Public Act 56 of 2019, Section 1063 Report – Workforce Investment Act (WIA) and Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Available Funds

Per Public Act 56 of 2019, Section 1063, the Talent Investment Agency shall report by February 15 to the Senate and House subcommittees on General Government, the fiscal agencies, and the State Budget Director on the amount by fiscal year of federal Workforce Investment Act of 1988, Public Law 105-220, and Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, 19 USC 3101 to 3361, funds appropriated under this section. (Since the PA took effect, under Executive Order 2019-13 the Talent Investment Agency was dissolved and replaced by the Office of Employment & Training at the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity.)

The amount of WIA and WIOA funds available from prior fiscal years total \$62,418,619. WIA and WIOA funds are awarded on a federal program year of July 1 through June 30 and are available for expenditure for three years from the date of the federal award. Use of these funds can only be for specified WIA or WIOA program purposes that must be in compliance with federal regulations and consistent with the State's WIA/WIOA unified plan.
