RE: PA 87 of 2021, Sec. 1063(2) Report

Per Public Act 87 of 2021, Section 1063(2), the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity shall report on the amount of funds appropriated by fiscal year under the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), 29 USC 3101 to 3361.

The amount of WIOA funds available from prior fiscal years total \$63,336,854. WIOA funds are awarded on a federal program year of July 1 through June 30 and are available for expenditure for three years from the date of the federal award. Use of these funds can only be for specified WIOA program purposes that must be in compliance with federal regulations and consistent with the State's WIOA unified plan.
