Public Act 53 of 2022, Section 359 (20) Report

Management of the Connecting Michigan Communities (CMIC) Grant Program has been consolidated into the Michigan Office of High-Speed Internet (MI-HI) from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation. Grants related to CMIC 3.0 have been awarded as of June 14, 2022, with required completion date of September 2025. MI-HI will also manage any outstanding grant issues from CMIC 2.0 and CMIC 1.0.

Pursuant to Executive Directive 2021-2, MI-HI is working to coordinate state, federal, and philanthropic and private investment efforts related to ensuring that every home and business in Michigan can access high-speed internet services that meet their needs.
