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ACH Credit Payment Overview

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Payment File Specifications and Submission

	Due Dates: • <i>Payment due dates:</i> – Quarter 1: April 25 – Quarter 2: July 25 – Quarter 3: October 25 – Quarter 4: January 25 • <i>Both wage reports and payments must be submitted by the 25th for the appropriate quarter.</i> • <i>If you do not submit your reports and payments accurately and on time, penalty and interest will be applied to your account.</i> • <i>Compliance with filing Employer's Quarterly Wage/Tax Report, online through MiUI will help ensure efficient processing of the employer's quarterly tax report and payment.</i>
	ACH Credit feature: • <i>The ACH Credit feature allows the employer and TPAs to authorize payments to the UIA for unemployment quarterly taxes or reimbursements using both the National Automated Clearance House Association (NACHA) Cash Concentration & Disbursement (CCD)+ and Corporate Trade Exchange (CTX) standard formats. You must contact your bank in advance to notify them of your ACH transfer amount. Most banks require at least 24-hour lead time. Please contact your bank for specific deadlines.</i> Submitting Payment for Multiple UIA Accounts: • <i>UIA treats each employer account number as a separate entity for the purposes of processing ACH credit payments. Therefore, if you are submitting a payment for multiple UIA account numbers, a separate addenda record must be submitted for each account. Use the CTX format if you are submitting a payment with multiple addenda records.</i>

	<i>Tips to Ensure a Successful Transaction</i> • <i>ACH credit payments must include a valid EAN number for payment to be processed.</i> • <i>TPAs submitting ACH payments for employer(s) must be associated with the employer account and be assigned the Edit Tax Payments Update and Submit role.</i> • <i>TPAs must also include a valid EAN and TPA ID for payment processing.</i>

7	Company Entry Description	Alpha-Numeric	10	Your description of the transaction. This may be printed on the receivers' bank statement by the Receiving Financial Institution. (i.e., Payroll)
8	Company Descriptive Date	Alpha-Numeric	6	OPTIONAL: The date you choose to identify the transactions. This date may be printed on the participants' bank statement by the Receiving Financial Institution.

9	Effective Entry Date	YYMMDD	6	Date transactions are to be posted to the participants' account.
10	Settlement Date	Blanks	3	Leave this field blank. Inserted by ACH Operator
11	Originator Status Code	'1'	1	Enter "1". This identifies Chase Manhattan/Standard Federal as a depository financial institution, which is bound by the rules of the ACH.
