

## NOTICE OF DUA APPLICATION ERROR

This notice is to inform you of an error in two of the dates published in the Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) Application Packet. The packet was available for a limited time to allow Michigan residents whose work was impacted by the August 2023 storms to apply for benefits if they were out of work due to the disaster.

Throughout the packet, the Unemployment Insurance Agency (UIA) correctly stated the period to apply for unemployment benefits ended March 27, 2024. However, on page 2 of Form UIA 6333-DUA, *Notice of Disaster Unemployment Assistance*, the deadline for submitting the application was incorrectly listed as March 27, 2027. This date should have been listed as March 27, 2024.

Also, on Form UIA 1554-DUA, *Disaster Unemployment Assistance Self-Employment Application and Wage Statement* worksheet where applicants were required to record the hours worked, the week ending date of 5/12/2022 should have been 5/12/2024.

UIA is providing notice of the error for informational purposes, however, the application deadline of March 27, 2024, did not change.

If you mailed in your DUA application after the expiration period of March 27, 2024, you are required to include a written statement about why the application was submitted after the deadline. Each application will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
