Job search seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in job search related webinars or course sponsored by placement agencies, including educational institutions.

> Application on PMTC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upload your resume at MiTalent.org and make it searchable for employers. • Using resources available at a Michigan Works office such as obtaining job postings for jobs listed by local employers and one contact made.
> Job fair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend an in-person or virtual job fair or hiring event and make contact with at least one employer.
> RESEA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in a Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) initial or follow-up appointment.
> Skills evaluation/assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in private sector paid or unpaid work experience or internship. • Complete an online interest inventory (e.g., Strong, My Next Move, Myers/Briggs). • Complete ACT WorkKeys assessment. • Obtain a National Work Readiness Credential. • Participate in an occupational skills or computer course.
> Workshop	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend either virtual or in-person job search seminars workshops or courses that help improve skills for finding employment. • Complete an online interest inventory (e.g., Strong, My Next Move, Myers/Briggs). • Complete ACT WorkKeys assessment. • Obtain a National Work Readiness Credential. • Participate in an occupational skills or computer course. • Enroll in the Clean Slate Program through your local Michigan Works.
