Re: Announcement of Planned Action in Warren, Michigan

Dear Sir or Madam:

Consistent with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (“WARN”), we are writing to inform you that General Motors LLC’s GM Global Technical Center located at 29427 Louis Chevrolet Road, Warren, Michigan 48093 (“GM Global Tech Center”), will be separating the employment of a group of 634 employees.

Beginning on August 19, 2024, affected employees will no longer report to work and their normal work responsibilities will cease. The affected employees may devote all of their time to job search efforts, retraining, and/or other transitional activities. The affected employees will continue to be employed until September 3, 2024, which will be their last day in the payroll system. The affected employees will receive a payment equivalent to their wages and benefits as if they were employed through October 18, 2024.

These separations are expected to be permanent at the GM Global Tech Center. The remaining employees at the GM Global Tech Center will continue to be employed after these separations. The affected employees do not have any bumping rights. The affected employees are not represented by a Union.

The attached Exhibit A is a list of the job positions and number of individuals in those job positions who will be affected by the separations.
