Michigan Alliance Data Bites 2022-2023

- VISITORS TO OUR INFORMATIONAL WEBSITE...**
Between October 1, 2022 and September 30, 2023, we had 548,526 page views.
- YOUTUBE VIEWS OF ARCHIVED VIDEOS...**
During the same time period, we had 19,940 views of our videos.
- SOCIAL MEDIA REACH...**
We expanded our social presence; 524,757 was our total FB reach; we also jumpstarted our Instagram with 1,972 people reached in the first month.
- OUR REGIONAL PARENT MENTORS (RPMs)...**
Responded to 14,750 requests for assistance from parents, students, and professionals.
- INFORMATION DISSEMINATED...**
1,839,337 pieces of literature and promotional items at events, through outreach, and learning opportunities.
- EXHIBITS AND RESOURCE FAIRS...**
Regional Parent Mentors had exhibit tables at 74 events, resulting in 1:1 outreach to 17,364 people.
- REFERRALS TO ADVOCATES...**
Our Regional Parent Mentors referred 503 unique parents to our statewide network of advocates.
- SUPPORTING PARENTS ON COMMITTEES...**
We supported 510 parents who were taking part on committees and councils.
- PARENTS AS LEADERS...**
Provided 1:1 support to 15 parents serving in leadership roles for local groups.
