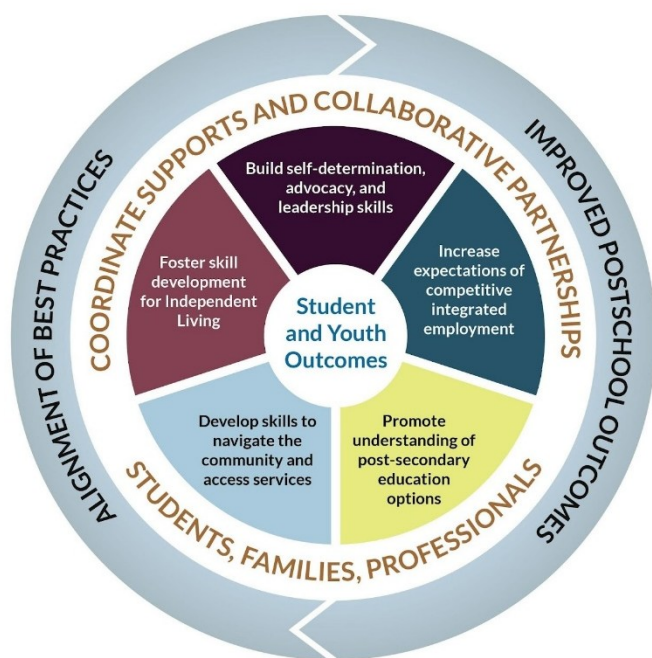

The Michigan Interagency Transition Team (MITT) is comprised of representatives from 21 agencies that contribute to the transition to adulthood for youth with disabilities. MITT members meet online once a month to work toward annual goals and to update each other on transition-related events and activities around the state. All of MITT's discussions and projects are based on the MITT model for secondary transition:



2025 Projects:

February 2025: Presented at the Michigan Council for Exceptional Children (MCEC) conference

May 2025: MITT members attend the Capacity-Building Institute with the National Technical Assistance Center on Transition (NTACT-C), to continue working on the strategic plan. The strategic plan is based upon the Interagency Agreement signed by directors of MDE, MRS, and BSBP in October 2024.

August 2025: MITT members will present at the Michigan Association of Administrators of Special Education (MAASE) conference

September – December 2025: As part of the strategic plan, MITT will continue professional

training based upon the Interagency Agreement at regional conferences and agencies. “A Guide to Transition from Special Education into Adulthood” is one of the materials for the training, to assist local professionals in educating families about connecting with transition services and adult services.
