Bureau of Services for Blind Persons Training Center Adulting Program!

This program is designed to help transition teenagers into adulthood. It will use real world situations to create a safe environment where teenagers can practice the financial aspects of being an adult.

- **Paid Work Experience** – Work a retail job at Goodwill in Kalamazoo, MI.
- **Learn about appropriate interview clothing-** Buy appropriate clothing for an interview with money provided by BSBP.
- **Learn how to choose and rent an apartment-** Compare apartment amenities, learn about paperwork needed to rent an apartment, and how to sign up for utilities.
- **Budget** – Learn how to budget work salary to pay for rent, utilities, other needs, wants, and savings.
- **Compare transportation options-** Compare money and time costs for different transportation options.

Ideal candidates for this program should be 16-18, planning on living independently as an adult, and interested in getting more experience with financial independence.

Background check, work permit, and medical form are required.
