**2025**

**Twenty-four (24) hours** of **Commission Designated** CPE as outlined below, completed by **December 31, 2025**.

No less than eight (8) hours shall be completed on MCOLES recognized **MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS** training.

**Suggested topics include, but are not limited to:**

- Behavioral Health Emerg. Partnership (*MCOLES 20hr. course*)
- LE response to those with Autism
- Alzheimer's Awareness
- Legal Updates related to Mental Health Crisis

*(e.g., Michigan Mental Health Code, mental health petitions, legal considerations)*

The remaining **sixteen (16) CPE hours** may be **on any agency selected topic** that meets the following three requirements\*:

- 1) enhances law enforcement performance, professionalism, public and officer safety, and officer decision making,
- 2) is pre-approved by the law enforcement agency head or their delegate, and
- 3) is registered/approved by MCOLES.

- Subject Control
- Civil Disorders
- Emergency Preparedness / Disaster Control
- Terrorism / Extremist Awareness

- Investigations (e.g., *criminal, administrative, background, etc.*)
- Juveniles
