A Resolution to Honor the Farmington Hills Police Department
for their Commitment to Community Partnerships and Training

It is with tremendous respect and appreciation that the members of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards offer recognition to **Chief Jeff King and the Farmington Hills Police Department** for their leadership and steadfast commitment to their law enforcement profession, the citizens of their community, and to the State of Michigan.

WHEREAS, effective response to individuals in mental health crisis is the responsibility of all law enforcement personnel and first responders, across ranks and disciplines; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jeff King and the Farmington Hills Police Department have chosen to problem solve through proactively building relationships with community mental health partners through the Commission's co-developed and co-instructed Behavioral Health Emergency Partnership (BHEP) training curriculum; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jeff King and the Farmington Hills Police Department have demonstrated dedication and performance above and beyond the standard by becoming the first law enforcement agency in the state to have 100 percent of their sworn officers, dispatchers and cadets educated in the Commission's 20-hour BHEP training; and

WHEREAS, the Department has developed strong relationships with behavioral health professionals and agencies by taking the steps to invest in the preparation of all personnel to make sustaining contributions to the betterment of law enforcement professionals, community mental health professionals, and community members in Farmington Hills and the surrounding areas; now,
