### **Background**

Commission members have received a computer link to the [Proposal for Decision](#) and the [Final Decision and Order](#) in the matter of **Dajuan Cortez Dickerson**. This matter was heard in proceedings conducted on August 16, 2024 at a telephonic hearing at the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules before Administrative Law Judge Thomas A. Halick.

### **Recommendation**

Commission members are requested to consider the proofs, findings of fact, and conclusions of law as set forth in the Proposal for Decision. Because **Dajuan Dickerson's** adjudications of guilt for false report of a felony, a four-year felony under MCL 750.411a(1)(b); and lying to a peace officer during an investigation for a crime punishable by imprisonment for 4 years or more, a two-year misdemeanor under MCL 750.479c(2)(c), revocation is mandated by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards Act, MCL 28.609(12)(c). Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission adopt the Proposal for Decision issued and entered by the Administrative Law Judge and revoke the license of **Dajuan Dickerson**.
