GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of the State of Michigan for a period of one year at the time of application.
- Be a U.S. citizen
- Have no felony convictions
- Have a valid Michigan driver's license
- Possess good moral character
- If required, must be able to pass the firefighters agility test
- Be MCOLES licensed; or attending a current police academy; or have obtained all necessary requirements to be admitted to a police academy.
- If not licensed or in a current academy, have passed the MCOLES pre-employment standards tests.
- Be eligible to be certified as Firefighter I and II. Certification is preferred but not mandatory.
- Meet **all** minimum standards as mandated by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, the Michigan Firefighters Training Council, and the Fraser Civil Service Commission.

The posting will remain open until the position is filled.
