Keego Harbor Police Department is seeking experienced MCOLES licensed officers for part-time employment.

KHPD is currently hiring part-time certified officers. We also encourage certifiable officers who are currently working in other fields but would like to continue their police experience in a part-time opportunity. You must have at least 2-3 years of certified police experience to apply for this position.

- Current starting pay is **\$31.60 - \$38.48** per hour (applicants may start with step-up pay depending on experience).
- Part-time officers are part of the Union/Collective Bargaining Unit.
- Part-Time officers receive uniform allowance.
- Holidays are double time pay.
- Overtime pay (time and a half).
- Full physical exam, drug screening & psychological are mandatory upon hire.

Keego Harbor is a city of 3,000 residents, located approximately 30 miles northwest of downtown Detroit, in Oakland County. It is approximately 1 square mile bordered by two beautiful lakes, Cass Lake and Sylvan Lake. There is NO residency requirement or limit on distance an officer must reside from the city border.

Current needs are 3-4 days per 28 day work schedule (at 8 hour shifts). More hours/shifts become available during summer & fall due to vacations. A qualified applicant must be able to perform responsive law enforcement duties, which include but are not limited to the enforcement of all state laws, local ordinances, and traffic laws, prevention and detection of crime, apprehension of offenders, promotion of positive community relations and public service, and any other law enforcement functions as directed by the Chief of Police.
