Road patrol officers perform police functions throughout the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Reservation. Officers are deputized under the Isabella County Sheriff's Department and the Federal Bureau of Indian Affairs. Officers enforce state, federal, and tribal law. Road patrol officers work 12 hour shifts. The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Reservation is 217.67 square miles and is located in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan. Officer must meet Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards MCOLES License.

The Saginaw Chippewa Tribal Police Department is a 24/7 department. Hourly wage pay rate starting \$25.78-\$36.90 DOQ.
