- A valid Michigan driver's license or the ability to obtain one prior to the hire date.
- Knowledge of the criminal laws, vehicle code book and statutes.
- Good verbal and written communication and human relations skills.
- Ability to work variable hours and shifts.

Associate's degree in a related field is preferred.
