ABOUT US:

Grosse Ile Township is an island in Wayne County, Michigan, located just west of the Canada/United States border in the Detroit River. It covers an area of about 9.6 square miles and is home to over 10,000 residents.

The department is made up of 16 full-time MCOLES licensed officers, along with 5 full-time dispatchers, an animal control officer and a confidential secretary. We work 12-hour shifts with every other weekend off. We get 14 paid holidays, shift differential pay and paid personal, vacation, sick and compensation time. Our department is accepting applications for the position of full-time police officer.

SALARY / BENEFITS:

The starting wage is currently \$65,058.69, with yearly increases on April 1st. Grosse Ile Township offers MERS as a defined benefit retirement plan. We are union members of POAM. We offer medical, dental, vision, life insurance and a wellness program. Each officer receives a uniform allowance and on the job training. Overtime opportunities and opportunities in specialized units are available as well.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

A Patrol Officer performs required functions including but not limited to, and designed to: enhance the community, influence vehicular traffic, investigate criminal incidents, respond to request for police services, maintain peace and tranquility, and uphold the Constitution of the United States of America, State of Michigan and Township of Grosse Ile.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- Regular and predictable attendance.
- Enforces the Township ordinances, State and Federal laws (as applicable) while abiding by the General Orders of the Grosse Ile Police Department.
- Conduct preliminary investigations at incident scenes, interview suspects and witnesses, document and compose reports in a clear and concise manor, investigate and document traffic accidents and communicate/relay information to investigators.
- Patrol the community roadways observing conditions and taking enforcement action as needed.
- Attend court cases and testify as needed.
- Respond to fire, rescue and medical calls for service.
- Inform general public on laws and ordinances.
- Attend training classes relative to their duties.
- Act as jailer, searching, receiving and processing prisoners.
- Act as dispatcher when required.
- Reporting observations and actions by testifying in court.
- Interact with the public in a variety of situations.

- No felony convictions
- Willingness to work shift work, including holidays and weekends
