



Change is coming. Will you be ready?

Beginning January 1, 2017,
a Veterinary Feed Directive order must be
presented to purchase feeds containing:

| Established drug name | Examples of proprietary drug name(s) |

| Chlortetracycline (CTC) | Aureomycin, CLTC, CTC, Chloratet, Chlorachel, ChlorMax, Chlortetracycline, Deracin, Inchlor, Pennchlor, Pfichlor |
| Chlortetracycline/ Sulfamethazine | Aureo S, Aureomix S, Pennchlor S |
| Chlortetracycline/ Sulfamethazine/Penicillin | Aureomix 500, Chlorachel/Pfichlor SP, Pennchlor SP, ChlorMax SP |
| Hygromycin B | Hygromix |
| Lincomycin | Lincomix |
| Oxytetracycline (OTC) | TM, OXTC, Oxytetracycline, Pennox, Terramycin |
| Oxytetracycline/Neomycin | Neo-Oxy, Neo-Terramycin |
| Penicillin | Penicillin, Penicillin G Procaine |
| Sulfadimethoxine/Ormetoprim | Rofenaid, Romet |
| Tylosin | Tylan, Tylosin, Tylovet |
| Tylosin/Sulfamethazine | Tylan Sulfa G, Tylan Plus Sulfa G, Tylosin Plus Sulfamethazine |
| Virginiamycin | Stafac, Virginiamycin, V-Max |

Tylvalosin (Aivlosin), Tilmicosin (Pulmotil, Tilmovet), Avilamycin (Kavault) and Florfenicol (Aquaflor, Nuflor) currently require a VFD order.
