



Wastewater Infrastructure Fund Overview

Purpose

The Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) is offering a grant opportunity in support of projects that address wastewater infrastructure needs within Michigan's food and agriculture industry.

Goals of the Program

MDARD will be assisting the food and agriculture industry to ensure compliance with Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) wastewater regulations under the Groundwater Discharge Permit Program, helping them move toward climate-smart practices that will protect the environment and public health.



Eligible Entities



Eligible Entities



The entity will be obtaining a permit or coming into compliance with EGLE's Part 31, Groundwater Discharge Permit for food and beverage processing, with a focus on fruit, vegetable, dairy products, meat, egg, and grain processing.



The company is in good standing and compliance with MDARD and the state.



Only one proposal per applicant facility location or permit number will be awarded.

Ineligible Investment Costs

Administrative & Consulting Fees

Bid out documents, as receipts of proof of purchase/investment are required.



Performance Based Grant

The grant will cover 50% of the eligible investment costs

If a company is eligible for funding, project milestones must be completed prior to receiving a disbursement of the performance-based grant



Award Amounts Available



Over \$30 million in program funding is available. Funding to a company is based upon daily flow and overall project investment.



Applications will be accepted continually until the funding is exhausted. The grant cycle is determined by funding awarded and distributed to approved projects.



A grant to an individual company shall not exceed \$2,000,000 and is based on a tiered system.



A company is required to cover 50% of the total eligible investment costs from other funding sources.



Funding Tiers



	Daily Flow (Gallons Per Day)	Award Range
Tier I	Up to 750	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$225,000
Tier 2	751 to 1,500	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$350,000
Tier 3	1,501 to 3,000	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$500,000
Tier 4	3,001 to 10,000	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$1,000,000
Tier 5	10,001 to 20,000	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$1,500,000
Tier 6	20,001 and over	50% of eligible investment, maximum grant award of \$2,000,000



Pre-Qualification Process

- Interested companies should complete the Pre-Qualification
 Form available on the MDARD grant page. The completed Pre-Qualification Form will be used to determine a company and project's eligibility for grant funding.
- Applicant should have an EGLE required Schedule of Compliance to upgrade the groundwater wastewater treatment.
 - Which could be included in an Administrative Consent Order, Compliance and Enforcement Action, Certificate of Coverage, or State Groundwater Discharge Permit from EGLE.



Pre-Qualification Form

- Information Requested:
 - EGLE Wastewater Permit Number or EGLE-Water Resources Division (WRD) Water Quality Compliance and Enforcement Number
 - Project Location
 - Project Purpose and Description
 - Impact on Michigan's Agriculture Industry
 - Status of Funding/Financing, Engineering Firm, Contractor Bids
 - Wastewater Daily Flow Gallons Per Day
 - Estimated Investment



Pre-Qualification Review



Completed Form Information Reviewed by MDARD.



Companies that submit a completed Pre-Qualification will be notified if they are eligible for the program.



MDARD confirms that company is in good standing with no compliance issues.



If qualified for funding, a company will receive an email from MDARD-WIF@michigan.gov which will include a Pre-Qualification Letter, Term Sheet, and instructions to complete the full application.





Full Application Process

- Once a company is notified that they are qualified for funding, the company is required to provide the following to MDARD:
 - Completed Full Application
 - Signed Grant Agreement
 - Documentation of Project Milestones
- Project milestones must be completed prior to receiving a disbursement of the performancebased grant.
- There is no specific deadline to apply for the grant as applications are accepted continually until the over \$30 million in program funding is exhausted.


